

Daphne left a lasting legacy which led to the founding of the Daphne Jackson Trust. Help us to continue realising Daphne's vision by leaving a legacy of your own to safeguard the careers of future generations of scientists.

Science, engineering and technology are indispensable in our everyday lives. It is essential we create a secure future in which SET professionals are able to take career breaks. Work life balance is a key issue in today's society with many more people taking career breaks for a variety of reasons; raising a family, caring responsibilities, illness and relocation to name but a few. If a SET professional has a break of more than two years it is often impossible for them to return to their careers at the appropriate level. The investment in their education and training is then completely wasted.



The Daphne Jackson Trust offers flexible, part-time, paid Fellowships during which the Fellow will undertake a challenging research project and a retraining programme.

The Trust has a 96% success rate in returning SET professionals to their careers after successfully completing a Fellowship.

Our success has been possible because of the tremendous support we have received from organisations and individuals. Leaving a legacy is a certain way for you to help SET professionals. Your gift will enable you to contribute to scientific and technological research beyond your own lifetime.

Your solicitor will be able to help you draft or amend your will to include a legacy to the Daphne Jackson Trust. This is an uncomplicated and lasting way to help us and it does not cost you anything in your lifetime.

There are two types of Legacy:

#### **Pecuniary Legacy**

This is a specified sum, or a specified item of value, such as a painting, property or shares.

#### **Residuary Legacy**

This is a percentage of the remainder of your estate after all outgoing payments, other legacies or bequests.

You are welcome to discuss with us any specific ways in which you would like your legacy to be used – for example, you could leave a legacy to benefit a particular field of study or to generally fund all Fellows and the Trust.
