



## Daphne Jackson Trust Retraining Fellowship Diamond Light Source Guidance Notes - READ THIS BEFORE FILLING IN THE APPLICATION FORM

Thank you very much for clicking on the link which shows you have expressed an interest in the Diamond sponsored Daphne Jackson Fellowship. This is a brief summary to explain the nuances of this particular opportunity, particularly as some questions on our current application form may not seem relevant.

- This is a new pilot model of Fellowship. The emphasis is very much on retraining and reskilling. This will be done by working on different projects at Diamond rather than on one particular research project. By the end of the Fellowship you will be reskilled overcoming barriers your career break may have created.
- This is a two-year part-time (0.5 FTE) Daphne Jackson Fellowship that will be hosted and sponsored by Diamond Light Source Limited.
- A PhD is not essential. We are very much looking for people with a background in electrical or electronic engineering who would like to return to this area.
- The standard criteria for a Daphne Jackson Fellow remain i.e you need to be on a career break of at least two years and the break must have been taken for a family health or caring reason. You must be resident in the UK and have a good command of English and be educated to BSc level in a relevant degree subject.
- **Publications are not essential**. The application forms ask for a publication list but they are not essential. We will consider all relevant outputs from your career.
- As this is a pilot scheme each applicant will be individually assessed so please give
  as much information as possible, clearly stating your career prior to your break, your
  reasons for a career break and any work you have done on your break, and your
  reasons for wishing to return to work now.
